

**Lab Assignment #01****Using Praat / Consonants of English**

**Lab session:** Class on F Aug 19 is a lab session for this assignment. You will have an opportunity to collaborate with classmates, get help with Praat, or ask questions about the assignment.

**Purpose**

This assignment guides you in installing and using the Praat speech-analysis software, and provides an opportunity to practice with the consonant sounds of English and their IPA symbols.

**Task****A. Prepare to complete the lab assignment**

- **Read** Praat handouts #1–4, linked from the “[Lab assignments](#)” page
- **Download** the Praat software from <https://www.praat.org> and **install** Praat on your computer, as explained in Praat handout #1 and on the [praat.org](https://www.praat.org) download pages
  - There are many options, including Windows, Mac, Linux, and Chromebook (using Unix)
  - Please let me know ASAP if none of the available options work for you
- **Download** the following files from the “[Lab assignments](#)” page and **save them on your computer** so that you can open them with Praat:

- Open Praat, load the [lab01\_words.wav] and [lab01\_words.TextGrid] files into the Objects window, and then highlight both files and click on the View & Edit button in the right-side menu to **open a TextGrid window** (see Praat handouts #2–4 for help)
- In the TextGrid window, you should see a sound file with a TextGrid that labels a series of words from 1 to 11 — **if you can see this, you are ready to start the lab assignment**

**B. Answer questions (1)–(3) directly in Sakai**

(1) Which **number** on the TextGrid corresponds to each of the following English words? *Type the number in the response box on Sakai.* (5 points)

bagel	furnace	match	squish
diving	houses	pocket	youth
either	lodge	rouge	

- (2) For each of the following consonants, give the number of **one** word that contains the consonant. (There may be more than one correct answer, but just give one.) *Type the number in the response box on Sakai.* (10 points)

[p]	[f]	[ʃ]	[n]
[t]	[v]	[z]	[ŋ]
[k]	[θ]	[h]	[l]
[b]	[ð]	[tʃ]	[ɹ]
[d]	[s]	[dʒ]	[w]
[g]	[z]	[m]	[j]

- (3) Submit a file containing a **screenshot** of part of this TextGrid, as follows. (5 points)
- (a) Find a word that contains the consonant [ʃ].
  - (b) Use the TextGrid interval and the `sel` button to zoom in so that this whole word, but only this word, is showing in the TextGrid window. (See Praat handouts #3 and #4 for help.)
  - (c) Click and drag your mouse to highlight the area of the sound file that actually corresponds to the [ʃ] sound. You can figure this out by selecting and listening to pieces of the word until you figure out where the [ʃ] portion is. (Don't click the `sel` button this time; keep the whole word showing in the TextGrid window.)
  - (d) With the [ʃ] highlighted, take a screenshot of your Praat TextGrid window, paste it into your word processor or graphics program, and save it as a file **in .pdf format**. Then upload your file where indicated on Sakai. (Please remember to include your name in your document.)

### Criteria for success

This lab assignment is worth a total of 20 points, as distributed above. Points will be awarded for accuracy, and partial credit will be given where appropriate.
