<i>Noun</i>	<i>'My' + noun</i>	<i>'This' + noun</i>	<i>Gloss</i>
səbap	səbapku	səbabe	'reason'
murit	muritku	muride	'student'
beḍuk	beḍukku	beḍuge	'mosque drum'

- For the segments that alternate, what environments do we see for voiceless stops and for voiced stops? Which would you propose to be the **basic form** of these phonemes, and why?

II. Now consider these additional forms.

<i>Noun</i>	<i>'My' + noun</i>	<i>'This' + noun</i>	<i>Gloss</i>
ket̚ʃap	ket̚ʃapku	ket̚ʃape	'soy sauce'
kulit	kulitku	kulite	'skin'
