One course can fulfill two requirements (e.g., non-IE and fieldwork); see DGS. Undergraduate courses (< 400) do not count towards any requirement, not even the language requirement. The same course can fulfill an M.A. and a Ph.D. requirement, including both language requirements. The non-IE requirement is not satisfied by the student’s native language.
